



Guidelines for Eva M. Long Professional Development Grants

The purpose of the Vigo County Education Foundation's Eva M. Long Professional Development Grants is to promote professional growth, development, renewal and leadership opportunities for experienced educators.

Current Vigo County School Corporation educators with a minimum of three years of full-time education experience are eligible to apply. The VCEF will award five grants with a maximum of \$500 per application.

Application Process

Grant applications should be submitted through the link on our website no later than midnight on the deadline date. (see VCEF website for specific date.) Applications received after the deadline are not eligible for funding consideration.

Application Language

Your application will be reviewed by a committee of community members with a variety of professional and volunteer backgrounds. It is advantageous to your application if you clearly explain any educational concepts/language or technological requests.

Post Grant Expectations

Grant recipients have one year to complete their professional development project. One month after completion, the grant recipient is required to submit a Final Report of his/her experience to the VCEF. These reports are vital in helping us report to donors and continuously evaluate how to help VCSC educators in the most effective way possible. The Final Report form can be found on the VCEF website.
