Education serves as the lifeblood of our community, driving progress and shaping the future.

Thanks to the unwavering support of generous donors and dedicated volunteers, the Vigo County Education Foundation (VCEF) has successfully pursued its mission to enhance and enrich public education through impactful programs and projects. The past year has been extraordinary, with the VCEF granting over \$215,000 in program funding.

The VCEF's core ability to impact education in the Vigo County Schools is by awarding teacher driven classroom mini-grants and principal requested school-wide grants. This year the VCEF awarded nearly \$88,000 to fund 146 classroom mini-grants and \$35,000 in school-wide grants. Although these numbers are astounding, it is more amazing to observe the passion, creativity and innovation of our educators in constantly finding ways to enhance literacy, engage families, expand math skills and foster interest in science in a continually challenging environment. Their energy is not only inspiring but contagious and yields the love of learning in their students.

Thanks to our donors we continued to fund our annual field trips to the Terre Haute Children's Museum, Terre Haute Symphony and Pioneer Days at Fowler Park. Our support continued through the summer with the Summer Math Magic/Writing Wonders Enrichment program and the PAWS (Performing Arts Workshop) summer program.

I am proud to serve as a member of the Board of Directors for the VCEF because it is an opportunity to experience community coming together for the betterment of education. Thank you to our Board of Directors for their tireless commitment and for the enthusiastic guidance of our Executive Director, Jane Nichols and Grant and Data Manager, Jennifer Kirsch. BATTLE OF THE BRAINS TRIVIA NIGHT

The "Battle of the Brains" Trivia Night is a fun night of tests (of useless knowledge!), dinner, and a live auction. Held in the fall, this new annual event raises money for the second-grade field trip to the Terre Haute Children's Museum and STEM programming.

BUSINESS AND BAGELS

Twice per year, the VCEF invites the community to join them at a selected school for school-wide grant distributions and program highlights. This event is typically held in the fall and again in the spring.

EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION BANQUET

"FORE" THE KIDS GOLF TOURNAMENT

This golf scramble is held annually on the last Friday in July. The funds raised from this event help support VCEF sponsored programs such as classroom grants, academic competition funds, attendance programs, summer math enrichment, school wide math and literacy initiatives, extended day tutoring, and more. LICENSE PLATES

The Bureau of Motor Vehicles offers a specialized license plate which benefits the Vigo County Education Foundation. The design features the Hoosier Family of Readers initiative. PAYROLL DEDUCTION

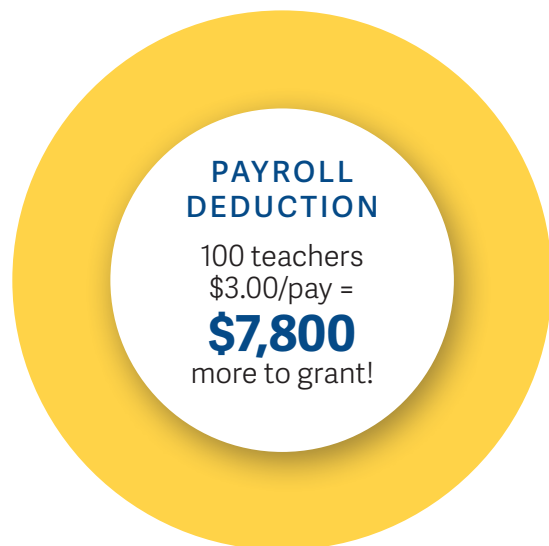

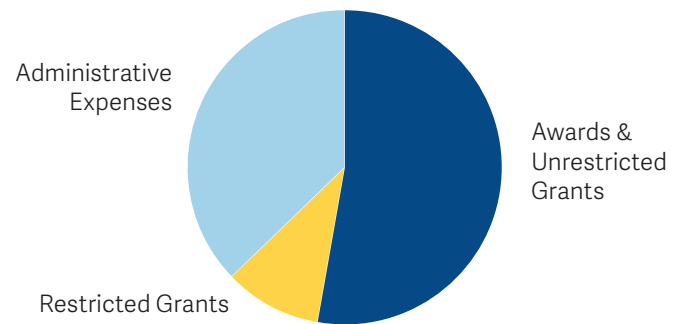
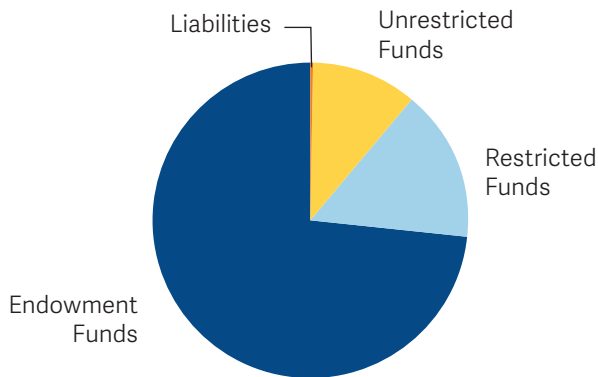

PROGRAMS

Community support helps provide programs which enhance and enrich public education.

ACADEMIC FUNDING

Funding is provided for entry fees to allow academic teams to participate in competitions.

BATTLE OF THE BOOKS

The VCEF funds transportation costs and equipment requests for a district-wide reading competition.

FIELD TRIPS

The VCEF funds field trips for selected grade levels throughout the school corporation. These include the Fowler Park Pioneer Days, Terre Haute Children's Museum and the Terre Haute Symphony Orchestra.

MATH MAGIC/WRITING WONDERS

The VCEF funds the transportation to these summer programs that serve second through eighth grade students. Students participate in problem solving and writing to learn about science activities.

MINI-GRANTS

Mini-grants are awards of up to \$750 given to teachers for enrichment programs they wish to offer in their classrooms.

PERFORMING ARTS WORKSHOP

The Performing Arts Workshop is a summer musical production performed by high school students and earns them a fine arts credit.

READ LIVE INTERVENTION

This program provides help in reading fluency and comprehension for students in targeted schools.

READING RECOVERY

This program provides intensive remediation for first grade readers. The VCEF purchases 'keep' books that are given to each participating student to prevent the "summer slide."

SCHOOL-WIDE GRANTS

School-wide grants are awards, generally \$1,000-\$3,000, given to principals for requested programs with a school-wide improvement focus.

TRANSFORMATIONAL TUTORING

This program provides extended-day language arts instruction to students in a number of targeted schools.



SCHOOL-WIDE GRANTS

School wide grants are awards between \$1,000 - \$3,000 given for programs which impact students throughout the entire school.

Applications are made by the principals, and projects this year included theatrical productions, attendance/behavior/academic incentive programs, CTE maker spaces, and literacy support including a book vending machine, and school wide math support, to name a few.

NAMED FUNDS

MAYNARD DAVISON MEMORIAL

Established by the Honey Creek Alumni Organization in memory of Maynard Davison, this grant provides for two CTE projects at Terre Haute South.

JOHN E. ETLING MEMORIAL FUND

This grant is awarded annually to a classroom teacher for an enriching art program.

FOR THE LOVE OF MUSIC

Created by Kathleen Culver to provide financial support to middle school students who otherwise might not have the funding to pursue their interest in music.

GORDON AND THARON GECKELER GRANT FUND

This fund provides an annual teacher requested mini grant which promotes literacy through family involvement and encourages the love of reading.

HIGH SCHOOL FUNDS

Funds (restricted by donors) for use at North, South or West Vigo High for a permanent project.

RODNEY HILL MEMORIAL FUND

Created by friends of the Hill family and used to support a teacher requested creative writing program.

JEROD LAWRENCE MEMORIAL

Created by the family and friends of Jerod Hoke Lawrence, to provide a one-time cash stipend for college expenses to the child of a Vigo County School Corporation employee.

MARTHA LAYTON MEMORIAL

This travel grant helps defray the expenses for one or more students to travel outside of the United States as part of an organized trip through North High School.

EVA M. LONG MEMORIAL FUND

Created by the Long family, each year the Eva M. Long Memorial will fund ten mini grants at selected Title 1 schools, a school wide grant for Terre Town Elementary, professional development grants, and a scholarship for a North High School student wishing to pursue education at Indiana State University.

ARTHUR LUKENS MEMORIAL

Created by Mr. Lukens' family, to support a teacher requested grant including the fields of business or finance.

ROBERT MARDIS MEMORIAL

Created in honor of Mr. Mardis' retirement from the VCSC, to provide a teacher requested grant at Benjamin Franklin Elementary School.

JOE MINNIS MEMORIAL FUND

Created by Pat Minnis, in memory of her husband, and longtime VCEF Member, Joe, to provide an annual CTE mini grant.

PIKER FAMILY FUND

Created by the Piker family to provide funding for five, third grade students at each elementary school to purchase books at their school's annual book fair, as well as a literacy-based mini grant.

CHRISTOPHER RAY/JERRY MODESITT MEMORIAL FUND

Created by the family and friends of Christopher Todd Ray and provides a payment of football camp expenses for one selected athlete at Terre Haute North Vigo High School.

REA ROURKE MEMORIAL

Created by Mrs. Rea Jane Linville to provide a grant requested by a preschool to grade three teacher for a parental/family involvement program.

This endowed fund provides a classroom mini grant every year to a selected media specialist(s) wishing to enrich their curriculum and media center.

TRAVIS J. SMITH MEMORIAL

Provides an award to a teacher wanting to provide a classroom enrichment project with a focus on at-risk students and character development.

SUPERINTENDENT AWARD

Created by the VCSC Administrators Association and used to support a teacher requested grant.

THOMAS AND CAROL TEMPLETON MEMORIAL ENDOWMENT FUND

This fund was created by the Board of Directors of The Hometown Savings Bank in memory of longtime THSB board member, Tom Templeton, and his wife, Carol. Earnings from this endowment will be used to fund an annual mini grant in the areas of either math, literacy or physical education.

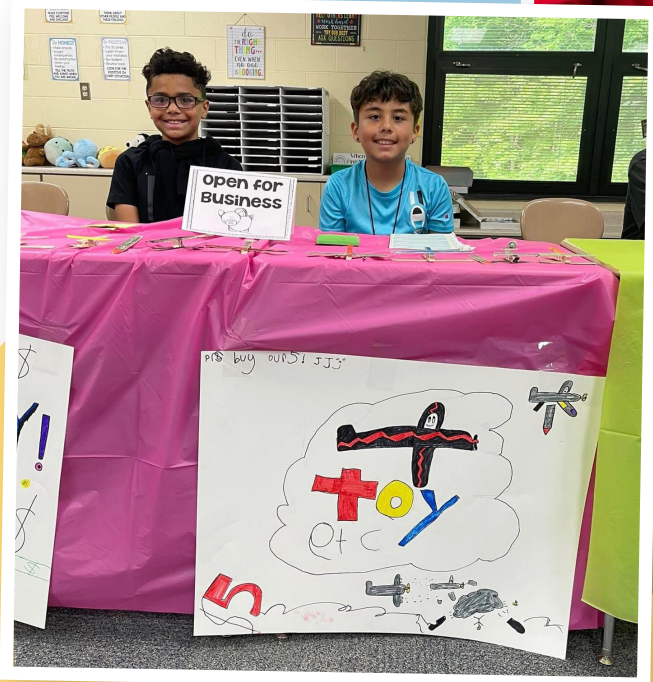
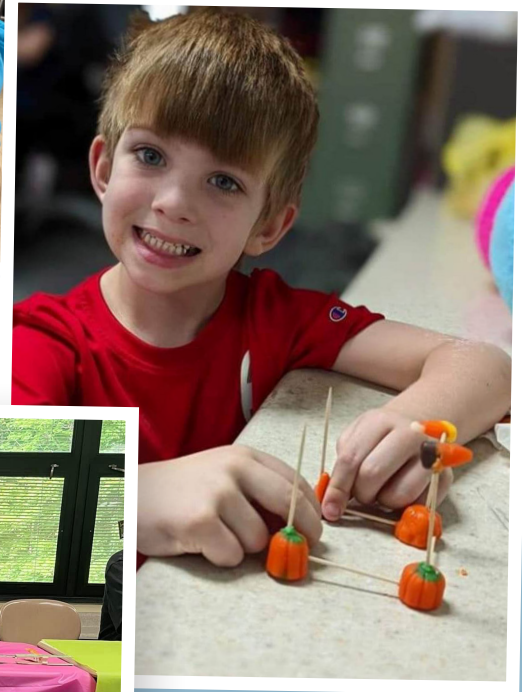
ANTHONY THOMPSON GRANT

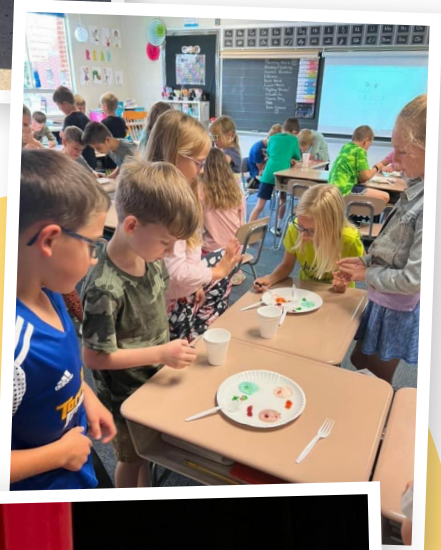
